Day 1 (Thursday 23.10.): Arrival

Individual transportation and arrival to Iceland.

Transfer with airport shuttle bus from Keflavik airport to your hotel in Reykjavik (tickets vouchers included in the package will be provided and previously sent) Check in at your Hotel RADISSON BLU 1919.



Day 2 (Friday 24.10.): GOLDEN CIRCLE (approximately 8 hours)

This day excursion introduces you to some of the most interesting and best-known natural phenomena in Iceland along the so-called Golden Circle.

Departure time at 9h00.

We start the day by driving to Thingvellir National Park (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) which holds a special place in the hearts of Icelanders since many historically important events have taken place there through the centuries. At Thingvellir the Icelandic parliament Althingi was founded in 930 and in the year 1000 Icelanders adopted Christianity there. Geologically it is also unique since this is where the American and Eurasian tectonic plates are slowly drifting apart and in the landscape you can clearly see the effects of the tectonic plate movements which have opened various cracks and fissures in the earth's crust.

We continue our journey to the famous geothermal area around the hot springs of Geysir and Strokkur. Here you will see numerous small springs boiling and bubbling and the Strokkur hot spring which ejects its water column high into the air every 5 – 10 minutes or so. From there it is only a short drive towards the majestic and beautiful Gullfoss waterfall that tumbles into a deep gorge.





Following the road through the fertile landscape and farmlands of South Iceland we return to Reykjavik. Free time for lunch during the Golden Circle Tour (as lunch is not included in the visit).

Day 3 (Saturday 25.10.): CITY SIGHTSEEING (departure at 9h00, approximately 3 hours)

A City Sightseeing tour will take you to the main attractions of the capital of Iceland. We stop at Hallgrimskirkja church, one of Reykjavík's most famous monuments and visit the historical city center. Here you will see the Town Hall, the Parliament building and the old harbor, dominated by Reykjavík's newest landmark: the modernistic Harpa concert hall and conference center.



Enjoy the rest of the day exploring Reykjavik by your own.

A variety of museums, cafés, restaurants, and shops can be found in the City Centre and along the main shopping street.



17:30: Premiere of the first act of Helgi R. Ingvarsson's seventh opera: **RAGNARÖK:** fate of the gods, in Harpa's Norðurljós Harpa Hall

during the Reykjavík Opera Days, in collaboration with the Chamber Opera (Kammeróperan).

We meet the Norse Gods, the Æsir, and see how their pride, lies and vanity lead to their deaths in the final battle, Ragnarök. The work is in Icelandic, Old Norse and English. The text comes mostly from the poetry collection "Ragnarökkur" by Benedikt Gröndal (published in 1868), but is also includes excerpts from Völuspá, Sigurdrífumál, Hamðismál and other historical sources. This first act of three contains 16 musical numbers and is just over 1 hour long.

19:30: Dinner at Art Hotel HOLT.





Day 4 (Sunday 26.10.): OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS

Optional: Whale watching (Departure at 9h00, duration approximately 3 hours)

Optional there is the possibility to embark on a whale watching tour from Reykjavík harbour to explore some of Iceland's rich sea- and birdlife. Enjoy the boat ride in Faxaflói bay to spot humpback whales, harbour porpoises and white-beaked dolphins.


OR

Optional: Reykjanes and Blue Lagoon (Departure at 9h00 - duration approximately 6 hours)

On our tour we are going to explore the volcanic nature of Reykjanes peninsula. After a visit to the colorful hot springs and solfatares of Krysuvik, we reach the fishing village Grindavik, which has been in the center of the most recent volcanic eruptions in Iceland. From there we continue through moonlike, lava landscapes to the lighthouse of Reykjanes at the extremity of the peninsula.

Finally it is time for a relaxing stop at the Blue Lagoon!

This unique geothermal spa is situated in the youngest lava field in


In the evening of SUNDAY 26th October more music events can be attended:

The full programme of 'Reykjavic Opera Days', apart from The premiere of 'Ragnarök', also includes Hallveig Rúnarsdóttir soprano, introducing a new CD and singing e.g. Wesendonck lieder, and a Choir concert, Young Nordic Opera Choirs, including Wagner, which additional concerts will be announced soon and more information will follow about it: https://operudagar.is/en/

Check out at reception before 11.00. Transfer with airport shuttle bus from your hotel to Keflavík International Airport.


