# Hotel nhow Amsterdam RAI: where views and encounters come together



From 19 to 22 February 2026, the congress of the International Richard Wagner Association (RWVI) will take place in Amsterdam. Hotel *nhow Amsterdam RAI* will serve as the home base. The welcome reception on Friday, the gala dinner with preceding recital and cocktail party on Saturday, and especially the Assembly of Delegates – all will take place in this hotel.

A better location is hardly imaginable. The assembly room is spacious, high, and filled with light, offering an impressive view over the city — an inspiring setting for reflection and consultation. At the same time, the hotel offers ample opportunity to meet informally: during breakfast, between sessions, or in the evening at the bar, overlooking Amsterdam's sparkling skyline.

#### Iconic architecture

This hotel is more than just a venue; it is a striking architectural landmark in the city. Designed by the world-renowned architectural firm OMA, founded by Rem Koolhaas, the building consists of three volumes rotated in opposing directions. The layered form refers to "*The Signal*" a former advertising column that once marked the nearby *Europaplein*. The result is a powerful, multilayered structure in which perspective, light, and urban dynamics constantly shift — a fitting context for an international congress with cultural depth.

### Location

The hotel is located in the heart of the *Zuidas*, Amsterdam's dynamic business and cultural district. It is easily accessible: Amsterdam RAI station is within walking distance and offers fast connections to Schiphol, the museum quarter, and the historic city center. Within minutes, you're in the cultural heart of the city. The location is also easy to reach by car, without the hustle of the city center. And on Friday evening, you can board the metro right outside the door for a direct ride to the opera house.

## **Rooms**

The rooms exude global inspiration. In color, shape, and material, influences from various cultures come together without losing their individuality. No uniformity, but rooms with character: vibrant, bright, and layered. And above all: with a fantastic view over the city. From the higher floors, Amsterdam unfolds in layers of water, light, and motion – a scenery that constantly changes. At the same time, there is space for calm and focus – exactly the balance that makes you feel at ease as a guest. Designed with attention to detail, but without unnecessary embellishment.
