To this day, the city commemorates its significant musical heritage through numerous historic sites and cultural institutions. On this tour, you will follow in Wagner's footsteps whilst discovering Leipzig, a vibrant city of music and culture. The customer may withdraw from the contract at any time prior to the commencement of the service.

Upon receipt of the written travel confirmation and the voucher, 25% of the tour price is due immediately as a deposit. The remaining balance must be paid no later than 6 weeks before the start of the trip.

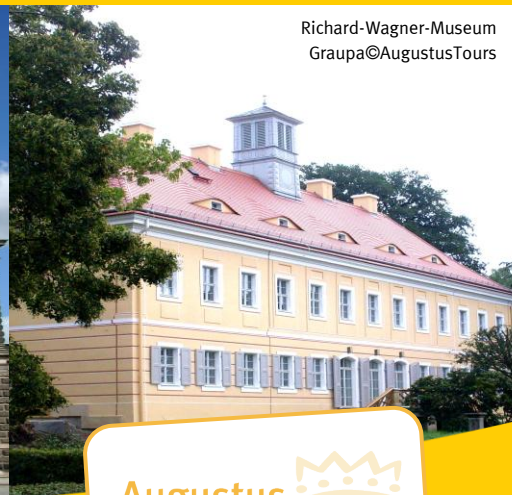

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Day 1, Thursday 20 May 2027

Your music tour to Leipzig begins with your own journey to the city by train, plane or car. If you are travelling by train, your hotel, the Vienna House easy, is located directly opposite Leipzig Central Station.

Your Comfort Plus rooms are non-smoking and equipped with a bathroom, toilet, cable TV, desk, in-room safe and coffee tray, as well as digital newspapers available to download free of charge and free high-speed Wi-Fi. They overlook the idyllic inner courtyard.

On arrival, you will find a complimentary bottle of water in your room.

54 underground parking spaces are available to hotel guests. Reservations cannot be made. The cost of 22.00 € per night has to be paid on spot.

Further parking options are available in the immediate vicinity.

In the evening, you will meet up for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant in Leipzig.

If you arrive in Leipzig in good time, why not take a city tour on your own? Alternatively, a visit to the Grassi Museum of Music Instruments on the grounds of the Old St John's Cemetery is well worth it. In this cemetery, you can discover the graves of Richard Wagner's mother and one of his sisters, as well as some remarkable historical tombs.

Day 2, Friday, 21 May 2027

You will meet your local guide and travel to Dresden in a comfortable coach. Once there, you will get to know Dresden on a short walk through the old town. Your local guide will have plenty to tell you about the city. Afterwards, on a guided tour of the Semper Opera House, you will learn just how closely this building is linked to Richard Wagner. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant in Dresden. In the afternoon, you continue to Graupa to visit the Richard Wagner memorial sites, which were once the summer residence of the court conductor Richard Wagner. In the evening, back in Leipzig, you end the day with a nice dinner at a local restaurant in Leipzig.

Day 3, Saturday, 22 May 2027

On Richard Wagner's birthday, Ursula Oehme, a member of the Richard Wagner Society Leipzig Board of Managing Directors, will take you on an extensive guided tour titled 'In the Footsteps of Richard Wagner'. Afterwards, you will have some free time and lunch at your leisure.

The big "Kaffeetafel" in the city centre, traditionally organized by Richard Wagner Society Leipzig every year, starts at 14:00. And of course, you will be joining it.

From there, you will walk to the Leipzig Opera House, where at 17:00 'Tristan and Isolde' will be performed

Day 4, Sunday, 23 May 2027

Your local guide will accompany you to the Bach House, where you will learn about the life and work of Johann Sebastian Bach, the Thomaskantor, during a guided tour.

You are expected for lunch at 'Auerbach's Keller'.

After lunch, you have some free time before meeting up again in the hotel lobby at 16:15 to have a stroll to the opera together.

There, from 17:00, you will enjoy 'The Flying Dutchman'.

Day 5, Monday, 24 May 2027

After breakfast, you will set off on your own journey home, your minds filled with experiences and memories.
