Foreword

Dear Wagner community worldwide,

A brief glance at the four previously published RWVI newsletters demonstrates that there are an incredible number of new, interesting and high-quality performances of Richard Wagner's masterpieces being performed in almost every part of the world. The Wagner Societies are also active and significant in very diverse ways. Similarly, the local relationships of Societies with both larger and smaller cultural organisations are generally productive and work well for both parties.

At some special events in the year, such as the International Richard Wagner Congress, the Bayreuth Festival, or at anniversaries, vocal competitions or symposia held both by member societies and the RWVI, there are also interregional meetings and networking events taking place between local societies and individual members.

Often, however, one finds oneself pressed for time at such events, and of course one would understandably not miss the first act of the "Valkyrie" or "Götterdämmerung". You end up saying "Ciao, we'll see each other later," after the obligatory courtesies are exchanged and that tends to happen too often in our opinion.

It would be great if we could make use of opera visits in other cities and in other countries, whether travelling solo or in groups, to make contact with the local Wagner Society in advance. A special local event - announced in the newsletter - always provides an opportunity for an amicable get-together in the context of the art of our "master", as well as for an exchange of experiences on society matters.

Let us therefore be more imaginative in welding together even more closely the international Wagner community. Our Newsletters can draw attention to such possibilities and can help to motivate them.

It is important to let interested parties know about events that can be of more than purely local interest. This is the main purpose of the calendar of events on the RWVI website, which can be updated regularly and in good time if you submit your contributions to us.

It will then only be necessary for event organisers to appoint specific times and places or a special item in the programme for more than a "Hello! How goes it ... Ciao until later..."

Have fun and enjoy reading this newsletter with this in mind.

The Finnish Wagner Society celebrated its 25th anniversary last autumn

In honour of the anniversary Die Stipendiumstiftung allows the society to send three scholarship holders, mezzosoprano Anu Ontronen, pianist, correpetitor Laura Kivikoski and bass Matti Turunen to Bayreuth this summer. Our membership number continues to grow and the FWS now is with its 834 members the third largest member society of RWVI. This summer the society will organize opera tours to the Stockholm Ring in May (40 members) and 34 members to Kuressaare Opera Days in Estonia in July (Lohengrin).

The Ring in Leipzig in 2018 has aroused great interest and appr 90 members will take part in that coming tour.

The Finnish National opera will produce a new Ring in 2019-2021. The tetralogy will start with the Rhinegold in autumn 2019, The Valkyries will follow in spring 2020, Siegfried in autumn 2020 and The Twilight of Gods in spring 2021. This new Ring will be conducted by Esa-Pekka Salonen. The role of Wotan will be sung by Tommi Hakala and as Bruennhilde we will hear Johanna Rusanen-Kartano.
